

Privacy Notice regarding cookies

Rheinmetall 4iG Digital Services Kft. (hereinafter referred to as "our company" or "we") uses cookies on its website available at https://r4ds.hu/hu/ (hereinafter referred to as "website") in order to maintain and improve the services of the website and to enhance the user experience.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on the user's device by the browser that perform identification and collect information. A cookie consists of a unique string of numbers and is primarily used to identify computers and other devices that download a website. Cookies have several functions, including collecting information, such as remembering user settings, and allowing the website owner to learn about user habits in order to improve the user experience.

How can digital technologies be controlled and their use turned off?

In case of websites:

In addition to the cookies management options of the website, all modern browsers allow you to change the setting of cookies. Most browsers automatically accept cookies by default, they can usually be changed to prevent automatic acceptance and offer a choice whether you want to authorise cookies or not each time you visit a website.

Since certain cookies are intended to facilitate or enable the usability and processes of the website, preventing or turning off the use of these cookies may have the consequence that you will not be able to fully use the website's functions or that the website will function differently in your browser than intended.

1) Cookies essential for operation: We use these digital technologies because they are essential for the operation of the website. These technologies remember the settings you have made on the website. These digital technologies cannot be turned off.

We use these technologies based on our legitimate interest pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR and Section 13/A para. (3) of the Elkertv.

2) **Performance cookies**: We use these cookies to understand how users use the website and to improve our services and website based on this information.

We process these cookies based on your consent in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR and Section 13/A(4) of Act CVIII of 2001 on electronic commerce.

You are entitled to withdraw your consent at any time, but the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

Some cookies are third-party cookies, which belong to a domain other than the domain of the website you are visiting.

3. Your rights

- A. **Withdrawal of consent:** You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time without giving reasons. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing that was carried out based on consent before its withdrawal. If you withdraw your consent, we will no longer process your personal data and will erase or anonymise the same.
- B. **Right of access:** You have the right to know whether your personal data is being processed; if they are being processed, you have the right to request us to provide access to your personal data. You also have the right to request a copy of your personal data from us. If you request additional copies, we may charge you a reasonable fee. We may ask you for additional information to confirm your identity.
- C. Right to rectification: You have the right to obtain from us without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, you have the right to have any incomplete personal data completed.
- D. **Right to erasure:** You have the right to request the erasure of personal data concerning vou.
- E. **Right to restrict processing:** You have the right to restrict the processing of your personal data in certain cases. Where processing of your personal data has been restricted, we can process your data only with your consent or for establishing, exercising or defending legal claims, or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person, or for reasons of important public interest of the Union or of a Member State.
- F. **Right to data portability:** You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you, which you have provided to the Company, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit such data to another controller.
- G. **Right to object:** You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data if the processing is based on our legitimate interests. In this case, we will block your personal data for a period of time that allows us to determine whether there are compelling legitimate grounds for continuing the data processing. In the absence of such grounds, we will stop processing your data and erase/anonymise the same.

4. Filing a complaint to the Data Protection Authority
